The Afrikaner Broederbond (Afrikaner Brotherhood) was formed in 1918 at the end of world war one. The aim was to empower the White Afrikaans speaking public, by influencing affairs in the government, public sector, and business. The name of the organisation was changed in 1994 to simply "Afrikanerbond", but it is still exactly the same organisation.
